



BLS Basic Life Support

CPR Training for the Professional Rescuer

This course trains participants to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give chest compressions, deliver ventilations, and provide early use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). Students participate in simulated clinical scenarios and learning stations. Students work with an American Heart Association - Basic Life Support (AHA-BLS) instructor to complete skills practice testing and a written exam. Designed for professional rescuers, this course can also be taken by those who need or just want a more detailed CPR class!
